

What to expect with Motegrity—by increasing rhythmic movements of the colon muscle, it is the **only prescription medicine of its kind** that works differently for adults with CIC.

*The ability of Motegrity to relieve the infrequency of bowel movements (BMs) was studied in six clinical trials lasting 12 weeks (Studies 1-5) and 24 weeks (Study 6), included 2,484 adults with CIC. About 3 in 4 were women and white, with an average age of 47 (ranging from 17 to 95), and many had been living with symptoms of CIC for years. During 12-week studies, Motegrity was shown to help normalize the number of complete spontaneous bowel movements (CSBMs) per week for adults living with CIC (at least 3 CSBMs per week on average). Chronic means having symptoms for at least 6 months. Idiopathic means the cause of the constipation is unknown.

Do not take Motegrity if you:

- are allergic to Motegrity. Allergic reaction symptoms may include trouble breathing, rash, itching and swelling of your face, lips, tongue or throat.
- have a tear in your stomach or intestinal wall (bowel perforation), a bowel blockage (intestinal obstruction) or serious conditions of the intestinal wall such as Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis.

It works differently by moving your colon muscle to help normalize complete spontaneous bowel movements (CSBMs)

- Unlike other prescription medications for CIC, Motegrity enhances the natural movements of the colon muscle, known as peristalsis
- Motegrity is classified as a "prokinetic" because it works by promoting colonic movements
- There are many prescription therapies for treating Chronic Idiopathic Constipation (CIC), but only one that works like Motegrity

Chronic means having symptoms for at least 6 months. Idiopathic means the cause of constipation is unknown.

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Before taking Motegrity, tell your healthcare provider (HCP) about all of your medical conditions, including if you:

- have or have had depression, suicidal thoughts or actions, or mood problems
- have kidney problems. Your HCP may give you a lower dose of Motegrity
- are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if Motegrity will harm your unborn baby
- are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. Prucalopride can pass into your breastmilk. Talk with your HCP about the best way to feed your baby if you take Motegrity.


Tell your HCP about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

How Motegrity helps move the colon muscle



Motegrity is the only prescription medicine of its kind for adults with CIC. Check out the diagram below to learn more about how Motegrity is designed to move your colon muscle.

Motegrity works in three steps to help get you moving



1 Ready

Taking Motegrity releases an active ingredient that gets absorbed into your system.

2 Set

It targets a specific receptor* in your colon and enhances the natural movements of the colon muscle.

3 Move

Rhythmic muscle movements in your colon are increased. This helps your bowels move.

*Receptors are molecules that help cells communicate and bring about responses, such as colon muscle movements.



Motegrity may help you get that "complete" feeling more often

If you've lived with CIC, you may know how rare getting those "complete" moments can be when it comes to your bowel movements (BMs).

During 12-week studies, Motegrity was shown to help **normalize** the number of complete spontaneous BMs per week for adults living with CIC.

Normalize means at least 3 complete spontaneous BMs per week on average.

CIC relief held steady through 12 weeks[†]


In clinical studies, Motegrity improved the number of complete spontaneous BMs per week as early as Week 1 and lasted 3 months (the length of the studies).

†Motegrity was evaluated in studies lasting up to 12 weeks.

People got that "complete" moment sooner with Motegrity

People who started taking Motegrity had their first complete spontaneous BM 1.4 to 4.7 days into treatment.[‡]

‡Compared to patients taking a placebo—a pill with no active ingredient—ranged from 1.4 to 4.7 days compared with 9.1 to 20.6 days across 6 studies.

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What are the common side effects for Motegrity?

The most common side effects of Motegrity include:

headache, stomach area (abdominal) pain or bloating, nausea, diarrhea, dizziness, vomiting, gas, and fatigue.

These are not all the possible side effects of Motegrity. Call your doctor for medical advice about side effects.

For patients who experienced diarrhea or headache, those side effects typically occurred within the first week of treatment and resolved within a few days of continued use.
